# A Curriculum Built for the Future

## How Lt. Dr. Nikki Brown is Helping Position DOC DASH for Mass Adoption



Thanks to her leadership, DOC DASH has been officially invited to participate in fall cadet training—marking a major milestone as we prepare to launch our digital curriculum statewide.

Every powerful movement has champions behind the scenes. For DOC DASH, one of them is Dr. Lieutenant Nikki Brown, Public Safety Lieutenant and Director of Urban Policing at Harris-Stowe State University.

When DOC DASH was presented to Chief Gary Hill—who later secured POST accreditation—Dr. Brown was not just present, she was instrumental. She immediately recognized its power: a structured system of communication that adds a proactive layer of protection for both officers and civilians.

As the leader responsible for training police cadets across St. Louis, Lt. Dr. Brown immediately understood how DOC DASH could enhance officer preparedness in the field. Her insight helped ensure the curriculum was not only POST-accredited, but also aligned with the current cadet training standards—a critical step in making it scalable.

That foundation has now opened the door for what comes next: Digitization. Mass adoption. Cultural impact.

# Standardized Safety Is In Session

## DOC DASH Triples Classroom Reach in 2025

DOC DASH has officially tripled its presence in Missouri schools, proving that students, staff, and public safety leaders are ready for protocol-driven engagement that saves lives.

DOC DASH launched a targeted impact survey focused on six key areas:

**Confidence | Practicality | Recommendation | Duration | Clarity | Behavioral Impact**

Because safer students don't happen by chance. They happen by protocol.

**Across all three schools, 485 students experienced DOC DASH – and over 93% reported a positive shift in how they view engagement with authority.**






In April we made our impact known at Life for Life aka Hawk Territory and engaged 73 scholars

What this means:


- DOC DASH's proven curriculum will soon be available in digital form
